LaGuardia Airport 2018 Bicycle Access Policy

In keeping with the Port Authority's mission to support the transportation needs of the bi-state region, we seek to provide bicycle access to our facilities where safe, feasible and practical.

In light of the increase in the use of bicycles as a mode of transport to and from the airport and to ensure the ease of access and safety of riders, the following action will be effective on April 15, 2018.

- Bicycles will be permitted to enter and exit LGA Airport by using either of two dedicated travel paths which are:
  - ➤ 82<sup>nd</sup> Street to Hangar 7 South.
  - > 94<sup>th</sup> Street to Terminal B Garage.
- Bicycles will be prohibited from <u>all</u> other airport roadways.

The two bicycle access routes will be furnished with additional bicycle signage and pavement markings, and each on airport destination will be equipped with new bicycle racks for cyclists to park and secure their bicycles. Because all other routes and destinations will be considered unauthorized, the Port Authority, along with our terminal operators will remove bicycle racks from unauthorized locations on LGA Airport. The two approved bicycle rack locations will have signs directing cyclists to nearby bus stops serving those locations. These bus stops, conveniently located adjacent to bicycle parking, will enable cyclists to swiftly and conveniently complete their journey on airport by bus at no charge.

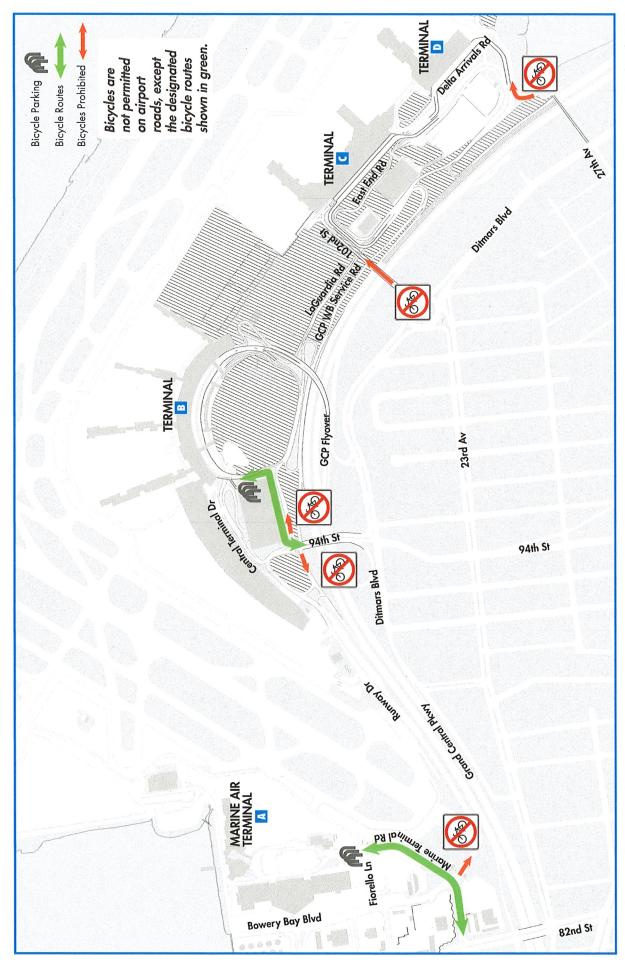
